NEPP: Neigbourhood Emergency Preparedness Plan

The forest fires last summer showed us the importance of better communication and preparation in these events. This plan is in place to provide us with the necessary tools to be informed and prepared at all times. Up to date information is available on the Columbia Shuswap Regional District webpage at csrd.bc.ca, electoral area E. We also recommend that if you have not already done so, you download the "Alertable" app on your smart device, if you have one.

- 2. **Bear Aware**: This speaks for itself. There are proactive things we can do to reduce the incidence of attracting bears. We should all do our part to prevent encounters with wildlife as it is detrimental to their health as well as ours.
- 3. <u>Fire Smart:</u> Information is available on how to make our homes more fire safe and educate us on prevention of fires and what to do in the event we are involved in a fire.
- 4. <u>Memberships:</u> (for those that have not already) A membership in the Community Association ensures that you will be linked into important communications and receive information about community events. We publish a newsletter every 2 months and look to you all to provide us with topics which are a concern to you that we may be able to assist with or provide more information on.

Today we are also dedicating our recently planted, beautiful dogwood tree at the entrance to our community, to the past and current members of our fire department. A special thank you to Mike Thoms for his assistance in tree selection as well as maintenance and beautification of our entrance. Mike was also one of our firefighters and most recently involved in the safety and protective services for our firefighters. Thank you to Cody Denovan, also a firefighter, for planting the tree for us.

Our firefighters are selfless individuals who voluntarily step up to protect us against some of mother nature's wildest disasters. I cannot say enough about all they do. We are fortunate enough to have a few of our retired fire chiefs, who still reside in our community, with us today. They are:

<u>Janet McQuhae</u>, who was on our fire department for 15 years, approximately 3 years as chief and prior to that, deputy fire chief and acting fire chief. She retired In 2019. Janet is still very active in our community and is currently managing the Neighbourhood Emergency Preparedness Program. During Janet's tenure the fire department were awarded official uniforms for the first time.

Ed Hermann:

Ed and his brother Don both signed on with the fire department at the same time, 30 years ago. Ed was fire chief for a short while. Both Ed and Don served many years on our fire department.

Our most recently retired chief is <u>Dave Schurek</u>. Dave retired last year after having been on the fire department for 15 years with the last six years as chief. Although retired, Dave continues to offer a very valuable service to the community through his knowledge of CISM and assisting individuals in a time of crisis. He is also a trained chaplain which is complimentary to critical incident management. He reminds us that this is the 25th anniversary of the 1997 landslide, debris flow and the 10th anniversary of the 2012 high water, bank failure and the first. anniversary of the wildfires.

An honourable mention goes to previous members of our fire department who are still living in our community: David Dahl, Claude Dubrule , Gord Parker , Patricia Kennedy and Mark Klynn. Linda Keats and Mark Kavanagh were on the fire department a number of years and have recently relocated to other communities. My apologies if I missed any names.

We wish to thank you all for your service in the fire department, past and present as well as your outstanding and continued support to our community. Let's have a round of applause for all these fine people.

At this time I would like to introduce Joanne Held, previous fire chief in Malakwa and good friend of the Schurek's to say a few words about Dave.

If there are others here today that would like to speak on behalf of other members of our fire department, I would invite you to come forward as well. Thank you!

We will continue working with new CSRD contacts to make changes, and have communication requesting timelines for our beach clean up / maintenance, playgrounds, garbages, and more. You will notice a blue mat runway at the Cambridge Road Community Park (mailbox beach) making this beach handicap accessible.

All beaches are accessible to the public in B.C. below high water. So the public can walk or sit along the shoreline if it is below high water mark but private docks and buoys are not public. However, if docks impede access along the shoreline, they must have steps up and down so the public can pass by them. Please respect the private signs on all docks. Thank you.
